Raymond R. Allis, 86, well known area businessman of 1619 C.C. Allis Road, Wyalusing, Pa. passed away Monday, March 16, 2015 at the Skilled Nursing Unit of Memorial Hospital, Towanda, Pa. Raymond was born in Rome, Pa on September 27, 1928 the son of C.C. and Retha Fox Allis. He attended grade school at Allis Hollow and was a graduate of Rome High School as Co-Valedictorian of the class of 1946.

Following high school, Raymond worked in the family business and was later drafted in the U.S. Army where he served from December of 1950 to November of 1952 in France during the Korean War. Following completion of his military service he attended Ridley-Lowell Business School in Binghamton, NY. On September 9, 1950 he married the former Betty Karpauitz at the Potterville Congregational Church. Following business school, Raymond returned to the family business, C.C. Allis & Sons where he remained active working full time until the time of his passing.

Raymond was a member of the Rome Presbyterian Church where he served as an elder for multiple terms. He was a Past Master and member of Roman Lodge No. 418 F. & A.M., Past President and member of the board of directors of Peoples State Bank and was a founding director of H.O.P.S. Ambulance Association where he worked on the ambulance and at numerous chicken barbeques over the years. Raymond also served as an auditor for

Orwell Township for a number of years. He was an active sponsor of local sports and played softball in the area until age 67. His love for traveling with his wife Betty took them to every major league baseball stadium in the United States over the years. Raymond enjoyed gardening and was an avid bowler having been a member of several leagues, hunter and fisherman. Surviving are his wife, Betty, daughters, Rebecca Dewing and husband David of Wyalusing, Raymeta Crawford and husband Jim of Wyalusing, Rosemarie "Pose" Foster and husband Greg of Wysox, grandchildren, Casey Crawford and wife Nicole of Rome, Cory Crawford of Bethlehem, Pa, Chad Dewing of Wyalusing, great grandchildren, Hailey and Noah Crawford, sister, Gladys Abell of Rome, brother, Donald D. Allis and wife Neva of Wyalusing, brother-in-law and sister-in-law, John and Dawn Karpauitz of Pottersville, sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Iola and Robert Cragle of Rome, several nieces, nephews, cousins and many friends. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his sister and brother-in-law, Doris and Freeman Dixon and brothers-in-law, Robert Karpauitz and Walter Abell.

The family will receive friends on Friday from 1 to 3 and 5 to 8 p.m. at the Rome Presbyterian Church, Rome, Pa. The funeral service will be held Saturday, March 21, 2015 at 2 p.m. at the Rome Presbyterian Church with Rev. Dr. Karen Ballard officiating. Roman Lodge No. 418 will hold a service of remembrance at 1:45 p.m. Saturday at the church. Interment will be at a later date at the South Hill Cemetery.
