Regina Joan Webster, 88, of 106 Ward Ave. Towanda, PA passed away Wednesday morning June 8, 2022, at her home following declining health. “Joan” as she was known by her family and friends was born in Towanda on August 23, 1933, the daughter of Daniel F.
