



Richard "Dick" Joseph Chamberlain

October 23, 1946 - July 14, 2018

Richard Joseph "Dick" Chamberlain, 71, of Hendersonville, NC formerly of Towanda, PA passed away peacefully in his sleep Saturday, July 14, 2018. "Dick" as he was known by his family and many friends was born in Providence, RI on October 23, 1946, the son of Donald George Chamberlain Sr. and Grace Hill Chamberlain. He was a graduate of Towanda High School with the Class of 1964 and later served with the U.S. Army stationed in Germany with the 9th Engineer Corps from 1966 to 1968. On January 7, 1967, Dick married the former Kaye L. Kenyon at the Monroeton United Methodist Church. In 1984, Dick graduated from Wilkes College where he received his Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration. Dick was employed by E.I. DuPont in Towanda from 1968 to 1992 and in 1992, transferred to Brevard, NC where he remained until retiring in 2003. Following his retirement from DuPont, Dick served as a tour guide with the Biltmore Estate in Asheville, NC from 2003 to 2012. Dick was a member of Towanda American Legion Post No. 42, Towanda Elks Lodge No. 2191, Towanda Lions Club, Towanda Country Club, and was a past president of the Towanda School Board. He was an avid automobile enthusiast, especially Ford model vehicles, and was a member of the Mustang Car Club in North Carolina. Dick also enjoyed spending time with family and friends, the outdoors, golfing, boating, hunting and racing go-carts. Dick was a loving husband, father and grandfather. He was deeply devoted to caring for his wife, Kaye when she suffered a stroke in 2012.

Dicks family includes his wife Kaye, son and daughter-in-law, Todd and Cheryl Chamberlain of Fletcher, NC, Leanne Chamberlain and fiance JR Mitchell of Seattle, WA, grandchildren, Max Chamberlain, Seth Wolff, Olivia Cole, Tanner Cole, Landon Cole, brothers and sisters-in-law, William "Bill" and Kathy Chamberlain of Delaware, Robert "Bobby" and Miki Chamberlain of Towanda, sisters and brothers-in-law, Jeanne and Rodney Schoonover of Towanda, Lindsay and Helen Chamberlain of Rome, PA as well as several nieces, nephews and cousins. 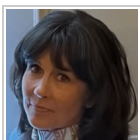
