Richard David "Rich" White, 78, well known North Towanda Businessman passed away early Wednesday morning, August 27, 2025, following declining health.

"Rich" was born in Towanda on October 6, 1946, the son of Robert Gerald White and Betty Sick White. He was a graduate of Towanda High School with the class of 1964, and subsequently served with the U.S. Navy for four years during the Viet Nam War. On December 21, 1965, Rich married the former Glenna M. Hallett in Towanda. On October 14, 1974, Richard and Glenna opened 3D's Pizza Restaurant in North Towanda and in later years expanded their business in offering ice cream. They enjoyed being of service to their community over the years and the many friendships they made. Rich enjoyed playing cards, shooting darts, and was a former dart champion in the area. Rich is survived by his sons, R. Darrin White and wife Amy of Sayre, Dayne E. White and wife Wynn of Statesville, NC, grandchildren, Ryan Michael, Nicole Whitney, Karina Jae, and Steven Tyler, great grandchildren, Cayden Robert, Carson Richard, Owin Michael, Lily-May Jo, Amaya Jo, Amelia Gean, Landen Alexander, Evin William, and Quin Marley, his siblings, Regina (Zan) Herr, Daryl White, Dawn White, Raymond (Debbie) White, as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins. 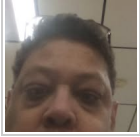
