September 26, 1936 - August 2, 2015

Robert L. "Bob" Dickerson, 78, well-known resident of 504 Third St. Towanda, PA passed away Sunday, August 2, 2015 at the Bradford County Manor in West Burlington Township, PA. Bob was born in Towanda on September 26, 1936 the son of the late Curtis L. and Helen May Dickerson. He was a graduate of Towanda High School class of 1954 and subsequently served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War. Bob was a graduate of Wilkes College class of 1961 with a degree in Commerce and Finance. While attending college he was employed by the Davy Tree Service. He began his career in banking with the Public Loan Company in Owego, NY and in 1963 became employed by Citizens & Northern Bank where he served as assistant cashier and loan officer in the Towanda office for a number of years and later as branch manager and loan officer of the Monroeton location. In 1982, Bob went to work for the First Bank of Troy where he served as assistant vice president of business development and loan officer of the Towanda office until June of 1988 when he and his wife Sandra became independent title searchers at the Bradford County Courthouse. In 1982, Bob became a graduate of The Graduate School of Retail Bank Management Sponsored by the Consumer's Bankers Association at the University of Virginia. Bob was a dedicated and active member of his community where he was a past president of Towanda Borough Council, past treasurer of the Towanda Area School Board, past president of the Bradford County Chapter of the International Management Council, director emeritus of Bradford County Big

Brothers & Big Sisters, member of Towanda American Legion Post No. 42 and the post's funeral honor guard, Correspondant Commissaire Intendant (secretary treasurer) of La Societe Des 40 Hommes et 8 Chevaux Voiture Locale No. 549 (The Society of 40 et 8) where he also served as Director of Americanism and was a former member of the Kiwanis Club, Towanda and the Wysox IOOF Lodge. Bob enjoyed archeology and was a member of the local archeology group participating in finds throughout the county over the years. He was formerly an active bowler in Towanda and Troy and enjoyed playing pool, the outdoors and cutting wood.

He leaves behind his loving and devoted wife, Sandra "Sandy" Engle Dickerson whom he married on July 11, 1970, daughter and son-in-law, Jennifer and Robert Schultz of Rome, granddaughter, Lauryn May Schultz, grandson, Nicholas Donald Schultz, brother and sister-in-law, Jon and Sue Dickerson of Seneca, SC, brother-in-law, John Engle of Towanda as well as several nieces, nephews cousins and many good friends.
