Robert C. "Bob" Heath Jr., 75, of Monroeton, PA formerly of Waverly, NY passed away Thursday evening, January 25, 2018 after a brief period of declining health. Bob was born in Sayre, PA on June 25, 1942 the son of Robert Charles Heath Sr. and Thelma Coad Heath. He was a graduate of Waverly High School Class of 1959 and along with his father owned and operated Heath Farms in Waverly. In 1970, Bob married the former Ruth Stalford and in 1976 they opened the P&A Chicken and Burger Pit in North Towanda. After 26 years of service to the community, they sold the business and Bob went to work part-time at Bishop's Hardware Store in Ulster, PA as equipment maintenance and repairman. Bob was predeceased by his parents, and his loving wife of 47 years, Ruth, on October 31, 2017.
