Robert John "Bobby Bump" Braddock, 65, of Towanda, PA passed away Monday evening, March 21, 2016 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Robert was born in Towanda, PA on May 10, 1950 the son of Fred W. and Beatrice M. Mosher Bump. He was a graduate of Towanda High School and served in the U.S. Navy from 1968 to 1972 during the Viet Nam War. Robert was employed by E.I. DuPont in Towanda for many years until his retirement. He was a member of Towanda American Legion Post No. 42 and enjoyed guns, the outdoors, hunting and hiking the Appalachian Trail.
