Roger Lee Druck, 66, of York Pennsylvania, was called home by the Lord with his family by his side on November 18, 2024 after a quick but courageous fight with acute myeloid leukemia.

Roger graduated high school in 1976 from Eastern High School and York VoTech. Shortly afterwards he started his career at the Foundry in Wrightsville, PA where he managed the core room and later managed shipping/receiving with Key Plastics of Felton, PA. He ultimately followed his entrepreneurial spirit in 1996 purchasing Pine Cradle Lake Family Campground in Rome, PA with the love of his life Cathy. Together they worked relentlessly to grow the business in a labor of love. Roger was a visionary. He had an innate ability to create something out of nothing and to accomplish a lot with very little. He was awarded employee of the month for a whopping 332 consecutive months- earning himself the title of Pine Cradle Lake's most dedicated employee.

Lovingly known as Pappy, those who knew him best admired his stoic demeanor and well timed, dry sense of humor. Beyond working, Roger enjoyed watching his grandkids play sports, reading books and solving puzzles, punishing himself with the occasional round of golf, and dunking double stuffed Oreo cookies. During the Winter months he also enjoyed traveling with family, taking cruises, and spending time in Florida.

Roger is survived by his wife, Cathy (Montgomery) Druck of York, Pennsylvania whom he was married to for 40 years. They were inseparable, sharing a love for camping, bluegrass music and slow dancing. He is also survived by his children: Wendy (Jared) Landmesser, Katie (Jake) Fiamingo, and Jacob (Lauren) Druck. His brother Melvin (Vicky) Druck, sister Connie (Don) Steinfelt, sister Peggy (Bob) Koontz. Grandchildren Ethan, Brayden and Addison Landmesser, Julian and Althea Fiamingo. Roger is preceded in death by his parents Robert and Dorcus Druck and his sister Sandy Keller.
