Ronald Paul Hitchcock Sr., 62, of Litchfield Township, PA passed away Monday morning, September 21, 2020 at his home following a long courageous battle against cancer. He was a graduate of Wyalusing Valley High School with the Class of 1976. Ron loved baseball and was an outstanding pitcher.
