Ronald Wayne "Ron" Willey, 79, of Monroeton, PA passed away Monday, July 18, 2022.

Born January 26, 1943, in Niagara Falls, NY he was the son of Leon A. "Sye" Willey and Kathryn Lantz Willey. Ron was a graduate of Towanda High School with the class of 1960.

In early years, he was employed by Herman Rynveld Sons in New Albany, PA. Ron was a veteran of the Viet Nam War having served with the U.S. Air Force in Viet Nam.
