



Sara May "Sally" Millard Dieffenbach

November 17, 1929 - July 1, 2019

Sara May "Sally" Millard Dieffenbach, 89, of New Albany, PA passed away Monday, July 1, 2019 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Sara was born in Towanda, PA on November 17, 1929, the daughter of Merle Alonzo Morse and Marian Blanche Chilson Morse. Sara attended Canton High School for two years and graduated with the Towanda High School class of 1947. While in Towanda she served on the Student Council. At the encouragement of her English teacher Miss Jean Holcomb, Sara served as a news writer and Editor of school events for The Daily Review. After graduating, with no funds for journalism college, she worked at Weldon's sewing Factory in Canton. Later, Sara took night business courses in Towanda and Wyalusing. She also enrolled in a correspondence course in Christian magazine writing. Sara married Kenneth A. Millard on January 1, 1948. They had five children, Marcella (Dale) Yasharian of Wyalusing, Wayne (Linda) Millard of LeRoy, Victor (Jan) Millard of Monroeton, Lois (Brice) Pardoe of New Albany, and Wesley (Linda) Millard of Erwin, NC. Sara was employed by The Sullivan Review in Dushore as advertising manager, news writer and photographer. In order to properly illustrate articles, she took a photography course by correspondence with the New York Institute of Photography. Sara became a photographer for the Sullivan Review, provided photos for the Wyalusing Rocket and The Daily Review and was a photographer for Wyalusing High School events. Millard Photos was the name of her studio. Sara wrote a column "The Craftsmen of the Endless Mountains" for The Daily Review and

provided feature articles for the Grit newspaper. Sara and Kenneth spent a sabbatical year doing prison evangelism with Hope Aglo Ministries of Lynchburg, VA. Sara served her community as Judge of Elections for Albany Township for several years and was a director for the New Albany Library. She worked with the Girl Scouts, was active in the Evergreen Christian Church as a deaconess, Sunday school teacher for both children and adults, served on the Missionary Board and sang as a church soloist. Sara took correspondent courses with The Moody Bible Institute of Chicago in External Studies and went there to graduate in cap and gown with the graduating class of 1995. Her husband, Kenneth, perished in an aircraft accident on April 14, 1990. There were five newly widowed women in the New Albany area in 1990. Through the guidance of the National AARP, a Widowed Person Service was established for Bradford-Sullivan Counties. It was a small group in the beginning, but through the talents of other widowed men and women, the support group grew quite popular. On November 27, 1999, Sara married Pernayo L. "Nate" Dieffenbach who later passed away on January 31, 2005. Sara was nominated and accepted into "Cambridge Who's Who", an elite professional registry of executive professional people in March of 2007. Following retirement, Sara established a wood working shop in the basement of her barn, to make small items and to do refinishing work. With a strong desire to write, Sara published her first book at age 75, The Adventures of Sally on Barclay Mountain with a strong urging of the Lord two additional books would follow, Everlasting Arms and Knowledge Revealed. In addition to her five children and their spouses, Sara is survived by many grandchildren and great grandchildren, special nephew Merle (Peg) Mott as well as additional nieces, nephews and cousins. In addition to her parents, Sara was predeceased by her husbands, Kenneth Millard and Pernayo "Nate" Dieffenbach, a granddaughter at birth, a great granddaughter and her sisters, Florence and Mearle Morse. The family will receive friends Sunday, July 7, 2019 from 2 to 4 p.m. at the Maryott-Bowen Funeral Home 217 York Ave. Towanda, PA. A Celebration of Life Service will be held Monday, July 8, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. at

the funeral home. Interment will follow in the Franklin Center Cemetery, Franklin Township, PA. The family suggests that contributions may be directed to the Evergreen Christian Church, the New Albany Baptist Church, New Albany Fire Company or to the Franklin Center Cemetery Association in memory of Sara.
