Sharon Palmer Miller, 77, of 334 State Street in Towanda, PA passed away early Friday morning, January 25, 2019. Born and raised in Troy, PA, Sharon graduated from Troy High School with the class of 1959. Following high school, Sharon worked as an operator at the Commonwealth Telephone Company. On July 16, 1966, she married the love of her life, Michael J. Miller at SS. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Towanda.

Sharon and Mike built their life together in Towanda, raising four children and dedicating themselves to a range of community activities. With a passion for children, Sharon provided day care in their home for nearly a decade, from the early 1970s until about 1981. Sharon delighted in surrounding herself with children and took as much pride in watching her "Mrs. Miller's kids" grow up as she did in her own children.

Sharon eventually returned to work at the Commonwealth Telephone Company where she remained until retiring in February of 1999. Sharon was a devoted member of SS. Peter and Paul Church in Towanda, the Altar and Rosary Society and was an active volunteer and supporter of church activities and events. Most of all, Sharon was a loving and devoted wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, and friend to all. She will be remembered for her kind and gracious personality, as well as her homemade baked goods, including English muffin bread, peanut brittle, and strawberry and peach jam.

Sharon's family includes her devoted husband of 52 years, Michael J. "Mike" Miller, children, Michael Miller Jr. and wife Mary of Hillsboro, NC, Maurita McCorkle and husband James of Raleigh, NC, Kathleen Miller of Arlington, VA, C. B. Miller of Towanda, grandchildren, Matthew and Jacob Miller, Kearia and Tyler McCorkle, brother, V. Bradley Palmer and wife Sue of Malvern, PA, several brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law, nieces, nephews and cousins. Sharon was predeceased by her mother, Martha Palmer.

She was a friend to our parents and admired by many in our church and community. I hope there is a more than a little of her friendship, laughter and love in all of us that we can share with others.

When Stephen and I were 3 and 4, we locked my mom out of the house on Main Street. We will say it was "by accident." She was always like that - there when we needed her, when her family needed her and when someone needed help...or a casserole. When she talked to you, she was most often happy and calm, but sometimes faintly entertained and surprised....we had a feeling that no matter what was happening, you were going to be ok.

Stephen visited with you all tonight and shared with me how many friendly faces and family were there. I want to say thank you to Mrs. Miller for all you did for us, and thank you to the Miller Family for sharing her with us.
