Sharon M. Yanney, 70, of Asylum Township, passed away at her home on Monday, July 1, 2013. Sharon was born in Sayre, Pennsylvania, on December 30, 1942, the daughter of Raymond Vough and Virginia Reid Havens. She attended Sayre High School and graduated in 1960. Sharon moved to Alaska with her family, where she lived from 1969 until 1980. While there she worked as an accountant for J.C. Penney. In 1980, Sharon moved to Waverly, N.Y. and was employed by Off Track Betting for 17 years, retiring as regional supervisor in 1997. In 1992 Sharon moved to Asylum Township.
