Shirley C. Henry passed from life on earth to the arms of her Lord Friday evening November 2, 2012 at The Bradford County Manor in Burlington, Pa. Prior to returning to Bradford County, Shirley was in assisted living at Stratford Court in Palm Harbor, FL.

Shirley was born in Emporium, Pa. December 30, 1922, the daughter of the late Claude A. and Laura Hatt Campbell. She graduated from Emporium High School in 1940 and was a majorette in the Emporium Town Band. There she met J. Beatty Henry and married him on January 31, 1942. Beatty worked for Sylvania Electric and his job took them to Brookville, Pa where their children Vicki and Rick were born. In June of 1955 they returned to Emporium, living there until transferring to Towanda, PA in February 1959. They resided in Towanda until July of 1986 when they built a home in Oldsmar, FL and retired there to enjoy the warm weather and golf.

Shirley will be remembered by family and friends for her beautiful handwork. She knitted, crocheted and cross-stitched many beautiful things as gifts. She was an accomplished seamstress and worked for a number of years with Edith Bonnell at her fabric shop in Towanda. She enjoyed playing bridge and golfing with Beatty and their friends. She was a member of The Kirk of Dunedin, FL., until her health no longer allowed her to enjoy leading an active life.

September 12, 2012 her children flew with her to Philadelphia and drove back to The Bradford County Manor where she has been graciously cared for by the staff.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Beatty Henry on May 23, 1998; her parents Laura and Claude Campbell; her sister Helen M. Prindible; and numerous aunts and uncles.

She is survived by her children: Vicki Heath of Stevensville, Pa; her son Richard Henry and his wife Arline of Chapel Hill, N.C.; grandchildren: Melissa Jaynes, Randy and Brenda Jaynes, Jennifer Vukmer, and Kyle and Braden Henry; great grandchildren: Gavin and Avery Vukmer, Riley and Justin Jaynes and Jade Henry. Also surviving are her brothers and wives Claude and June Campbell of Bluffton, Oh, and Jack Campbell and Toni of Wilmington, N.C. Six nephews and two nieces survive and well as "the other kids" Marsha and Richard Nemeth of Oldsmar, FL.
