May 31, 1948 - September 12, 2025

The Rev. Stefan Fabregas passed into God's kingdom on 9/12/25 in Athens, PA, after a long struggle with Parkinson's Disease. He was born to Joseph Fabregas IV and Marian Bubniak. Fr Stefan studied at the Ukrainian College Seminary in Stamford, CT and continued at the school of theology in Innsbruck then went on to complete canon law studies in Rome while residing at the seminary of St. Josaphat. He was ordained on 9/18/77 and joined the ranks of priests at the Eparchy in Stamford. Fr. Stefan served in many different parishes in the northeast and was loved by many. Survivors include three brothers and many cousins, nieces, and nephews. Panakhyda will be celebrated at the Ascension of Our Lord Ukrainian Catholic Church at 108 North Higgins Avenue in Sayre, PA, on Thursday, 9/18/25 at 4pm. Funeral service will be conducted by Bishop Paul Patrick Chomnycky on Friday, 9/19/25 at 10am at the church. Burial will follow.
