Stephen M. Stone of Sayre, PA went to Heaven on Monday, October 27, 2014 at the age of 55 after a shortened life by cancer. Stephen was born in Longview, WA on September 15, 1959 the son of Byron Delane Stone and Bobie Lou Whitney Stone. He was a graduate of Kelso High School, Kelso, WA class of 1977. In early years, Stephen operated his own chimney sweep business in Longview and later served as a Corpsman with the U.S. Navy. Following completion of his military service, Stephen worked in the medical field at several hospitals in Washington State and was later employed as a licensed practical nurse at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre and for United Health Services. He was employed by Lowes from 2005 until his retirement in 2010. Stephen enjoyed spending time with his family and faithful canine companion "Tiny", sharing stories, going to the beach, music and traveling.
