



Sterling Gerald "Jerry" Young

September 13, 1946 - January 4, 2024

Sterling Gerald "Jerry" Young, 77, of 33 Third Street, Towanda, PA passed away Thursday, January 4, 2024, at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. "Jerry" as he was known by his family and many friends was born in Towanda on September 13, 1946, the son of Sterling M. Young and Catherine Messersmith Young. He was a graduate of Towanda High School with the class of 1964 and while attending high school, Jerry worked at The Daily Review in Towanda. During the 1960's, Jerry was the organist for the Twilighter's Band which was well known in the area. Jerry was employed by GTE Sylvania in Towanda until his retirement on September 30, 2001, following 36 years of service.

After retiring from GTE Sylvania, Jerry worked as a truck driver for the Bishop Fuel Company, Pennsylvania Dept. of Transportation, and Chilson Brothers Paving Company. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Towanda for over 50 years where he served as a trustee and as church organist. Jerry was a member of the Towanda, North Towanda, and Wysox Fire Companies. He was a member of Union Lodge No. 108 F. & A.M. Towanda, and A.A.O.N.M.S. Williamsport, PA. Jerry loved spending time with his family and enjoyed volunteering for the Outstanding Young Women Program.

He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Cynthia McNeal Young whom he

married on July 9, 1965, their children, Lisa L. Young of Towanda, Heidi Jo Hetland of Durham, NC, Stephen G. Young and wife Dona M. Young of North Brookfield , MA, grandchildren, Stephen Gerald Young Jr., Adam Hetland, Elise Hetland, Stephen Bourret and wife Shannon, Christine Myers and husband Justin, great grandchildren, Layla Bourret, Jack Bourret, Jace Myers, aunts, Alice Shafer of Overton, Martha “Peg” Cook of Mansfield, PA, brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Wally and Sheila McNeal of Towanda as well as several nieces, nephews, and cousins.

In addition to his parents, Jerry was predeceased by his brother, Merle Young.
