February 11, 1931 - June 8, 2024

Steward L. "Stu" Rosengrant, 93, of Wysox, PA passed away Saturday, June 8, 2024, at the Personal Care Home at Guthrie Robert Packer Hospital Towanda Campus.

Steward was born February 11, 1931, at home in Roaring Brook Township, Lackawanna County, PA the son of Walter S. Rosengrant and Florence Sachse Rosengrant from a family of one sister and six brothers, Kathryn, Julius, Harry, Alfred, James, Lloyd, and Ronald. He was a graduate of Lake Vocational High School at Lake Ariel, Wayne County, PA in June of 1949. He married Cynthia Shultz on October 3, 1953. Together they had three children, Timothy Scott who died at birth in 1954, Garry Keith, born December 24, 1957, and Helen Elizabeth, born May 27, 1959, three granddaughters, one grandson, five great grandsons, and six great granddaughters. On November 11, 1965, he married Barbara Moon Hoffman, with stepchildren, E. Keith (Barb) Hoffman and Kevin Lee (Mary Lynn) Hoffman, five granddaughters, one grandson, seven great granddaughters, and five great grandsons.

In addition to his parents, Steward was predeceased by sons, Scott and Garry, sister, Kathryn, brothers, Julius, Harry, James, Lloyd, Alfred, Ronald and his first wife Cynthia. Stu started working for the Bradford County Dairy Herd Improvement Association in June of 1949 as a supervisor and later as manager with 45 years of service at the time of his retirement. He served for two years with the U.S. Army. Following basic training and food services school, Stu spent 19 months as a cook and baker at Schofield

Barracks in Oahu, Hawaii. For many years Stu was an active member of the Towanda United Methodist Church, Wysox Fire Company, Wysox EMS, and Wysox Chamber of Commerce. Steward was very dedicated to the Pennsylvania Dairy Princess and Promotional Services Inc. organization where he served as treasurer for 40 years. He enjoyed working with many Dairy Princesses and numerous promotions in support of the programs. He was a life member of the Dairy Shrine Association and the Voters Hall of Fame for over sixty years. Stu will be remembered and missed by many with honor and distinction for his love of family, friends, country, and community. When you were born, you were crying and everyone around you was smiling.
