Sylvia Moore Maryott, 89, of Rome, PA passed away Saturday, May 17, 2025, at the Robert Packer Hospital Skilled Care Unit, Towanda, PA. Sylvia was born in North Orwell, PA on March 17, 1936, the daughter of Roy Moore and Beatrice Boardman Moore.
