Sylvia L. Brenner Thompson, 80, of 29 Larch Rd., Sayre, PA, passed away at home on Saturday, October 26, 2013. Sylvia was born July 26, 1933 on South Street in South Waverly, PA, the daughter of the late Harold A. Thompson and Florence Shaffer Thompson. A life-long valley resident, Sylvia graduated from South Waverly Junior High School and from Waverly High School in 1951. She worked with her late husband, Dr. Sam Brenner in his office in Sayre until his death in 1986. She was later employed by the Guthrie Clinic in Sayre, retiring in 1997. Sylvia married Stanley V. Thompson in 1997.

Sylvia directed several church youth choirs and gave singing lessons. She was a member of the Athens Wesleyan Church, the Robert Packer Hospital Auxiliary, Valley Chorus, Church Choir, Polyhymnia Music Club, and the Waverly Legion Auxiliary. Sylvia also sang with the original Pro-musica Singers. She was a certified scuba diver, loved camping with her children, and loved all family get-togethers.
