THOMAS C. THOMPSON, JR., Certified Public Accountant

Prominent local businessman, Thomas C. Thompson, Jr. of Towanda, PA passed away suddenly on Saturday, November 4, 2017. Born June 27, 1949 in Amesbury, MA, he was the son of the late Thomas C. Thompson, Sr. and Ann Thompson-Haglich. As a child, he moved several times with his parents before eventually settling in Towanda in 1959 where his father managed the J.J. Newberry store. Tom was a graduate of St. Agnes High School and Villanova University where he attended the Villanova School of Business and earned a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Accounting. Following graduation in 1971, Tom began his career working for Roy Lipmann Accounting of Bryn Mawr, PA and then Touche Ross & Co. in Philadelphia, PA. In 1974, he returned to Towanda and joined the accounting practice of William Goeckel. He eventually opened his own practice as a certified public accountant in Towanda and assumed the practice of Roy Lipmann in Bryn Marw, providing accounting expertise to clients in both locations.

Tom was active in the community and served on many boards in the Towanda area, including Towanda Memorial Hospital, The First National Bank of Bradford County, and the Bank of Canton. He was a founding board member of the Central Bradford Progress Authority. Tom was also a former member of several service and social organizations including the Towanda Jaycees, Quarry Glen Club, and the Towanda Country Club. Tom was a U.S. veteran as a result of his service in the Air Force Reserves during the early 1970s.

Tom golfed and hunted, and particularly enjoyed gardening, canning, and cooking. He especially enjoyed family vacations at the beach where he orchestrated many gourmet dinners. He was also a devoted fan of the Villanova Men's Basketball team.

In addition to his parents he was predeceased by an infant son. He is survived by his wife, Elizabeth Thompson, his daughter Lennon Anne (Kim) of San Luis Obispo, CA and his son T (Darcy) of Towanda. He is also survived by four grandchildren, Grace, Joseph, Huntley, and Elli; his brothers William (Lillian) of Springfield, PA and Robert (Lisa) of Allentown PA; step father, Peter Haglich of Towanda, and several nieces, nephews, and cousins. Additionally, he is survived by his three stepchildren, Heather (John) Fugger, Rebecca (George) Glenny, and John (Amy) Rodnick; their children, Bria Maenner, Pierce and Ryan Fugger, Clayton and Elana Glenny, and Sutton and Sloane Rodnick; and one great grandson.

Tom was beloved and well respected, a loyal friend and devoted family man, and was always ready to share his time, kindness, humor, and friendship with all. He will be missed by his many friends and family.
