Timothy John Haeselin, Jr., 34, of Virginia Beach, VA passed away early Sunday morning, September 20, 2015 in Sayre, PA following a motorcycle accident.

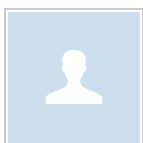

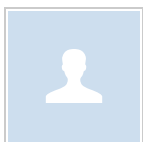

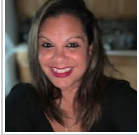
