Todd Kent Campbell, 53, of 615 S. Main St. Athens, PA passed away Wednesday evening, October 11, 2017 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre,

PA. Todd was born in

Towanda, PA on October 30, 1963. He was a graduate of SRU High School with

the Class of 1982 and later served with the U.S. Navy during the Persian Gulf War. Following completion of his military service, he was employed on commercial construction projects in Toronto, Canada. For a number of years, Todd operated his own stone quarry and trucking business in Pennsylvania and

New York state. He currently owned and operated a commercial snow removal

business in the valley area and a water transfer site for the natural gas industry

in Athens Township. Todd was a social member of Roma Madre Lodge No. 1342 Order Sons & Daughters of Italy in Sayre. He served as a town councilman

for Athens Borough beginning on January 1, 2008, was appointed to the President of the Athens Borough City Council on June 9, 2008, and resigned on

September 1, 2010. His family includes his wife 29 years Gemma Mendoza Cruz

Campbell, mother, Sandra Campbell of Athens, biological mother, Kay Johnson

of Fort Mill, South Carolina, Mother in law Rosie Mendoza, children, Jeff G. Campbell and wife Tara, Dionnace J. Campbell, and Tyler T. Campbell all of Athens.
