Virginia was born October 20, 1923 in Clearfield, PA. the daughter of the late Lee Cyrus Solt and Edith Pearl Passmore Solt. She was a graduate of Bellefonte High School Class of 1941. Virginia received her Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from the Harrisburg General Hospital School of Nursing and completed post graduate work in obstetrics at the Jersey City Medical Center. She was proud of her service in the Army Nurses Corps and later served as clinical instructor in obstetrics at Elizabeth General Hospital. Virginia received her Master's Degree in Nursing from Mansfield University. On June 12, 1954, she married Walter Robert Rieck in Bellefonte, PA. Virginia served as school nurse for the Towanda Middle School for 17 years until her retirement.
