



## Vivian E. "Vi" Abbott

Vivian E. "Vi" Abbott, 90, of Towanda, PA passed away Sunday evening, January 21, 2024, at her home following declining health. Vivian was born in Gillett, PA on June 20, 1933, the daughter of Karl and Bernice Ameigh Teribury. "Vi" as she was known by her family and friends grew up in Gillett and was a graduate of Troy High School. In early years, Vi was employed by Westinghouse in Horseheads, NY.
