



## Warren M. "Mac" Davenport

July 6, 1934 - October 1, 2018

Warren M. "Mac" Davenport, 84, well known Sayre businessman and resident of Wysox, PA passed away early Monday morning, October 1, 2018 at his home. "Mac" as he was known by his family and friends was born in Sayre, PA on July 6, 1934 the son of James and Lois MacGuffie Davenport. He was a graduate of Sayre High School with the class of 1952 and later served with the U.S. Army 150th Armored Cavalry Regiment during the Korean War. Following completion of his military service, Mac returned home and was employed as a mechanic for several area businesses. Mac owned and operated Davenports Garage in Sayre for many years until July of 2018 when declining health no longer permitted him to continue.

Mac served as a Pennsylvania Fish and Game Warden in the area for over 25 years. He loved the outdoors, hunting, fishing and was a noted stock car driver and supporter of stock car racing at local tracks for many years. Mac was a member of Sayre American Legion Post No. 283 and Skiff-Bower VFW Post No. 1536 Sayre where he also served as a board member, the Valley Color Guard, and Catholic War Veterans Post No. 773, Sayre. Mac was the recipient of the Quilt of Honor presented by Skiff-Bower VFW Post, Sayre, on September 26, 2018.

Surviving are his children, Kay Calaman and husband David of Monroeton, PA, Todd Davenport and wife Cindy of Cortland, NY, Wayne Davenport and wife Jessica of Candor, NY, several grandchildren and great grandchildren, sisters-in-law, Shirley Homan of Athens, PA, Peggy Thomas of West

Burlington, PA, brother-in-law, Charles VanHorn of Canton, PA as well as several nieces, nephews and cousins.

In addition to his parents he was predeceased by his wife, Margaret Yvonne VanHorn Davenport on November 15, 2005, sister, Martha Schreck and brothers, Robert and Jim Davenport. A private graveside service will be held at the Wysox Cemetery, Wysox, PA with members of the Valley Color Guard according full military honors.
