



William (Lloyd) Sullivan

January 6, 1932 - December 20, 2014

William (Lloyd) Sullivan, 82, passed into eternal life on December 20, 2014 at the Robert Packer Hospital in Sayre, PA. Lloyd was born at the Tioga General Hospital, Waverly, NY on January 6, 1932 and was the only child of William and Mary Homan Sullivan. As a child, Lloyd was tutored by his mom and learned to work on the family farm in Milan, PA. After his father passed, his mom re-married to John “Jack” Vetter. His mother and step-father continued to help Lloyd to learn to live independently.

Lloyd worked on various farms for family and friends until he moved to Athens in 1980. Lloyd became part of the Penn York Opportunities program, where he worked until he was 80 years old, finally retiring in the spring of 2012. Lloyd was an adopted member of Athens Borough and would often be seen walking to and from Penn York or on his way to Sam’s Restaurant for breakfast. Lloyd was a dedicated worker and a faithful friend his entire life. He loved visiting family members for holidays and never forgot his leftovers. One of his favorite pastimes was going to dinner with Dan Walsh at local restaurants. Lloyd was a devoted member of the Catholic faith and was a loyal member of St. Joseph’s/Epiphany Parish.

Lloyd is survived by his cousins Margaret (Tom) Murphy, Alice Bustin, and Rita May, as well as many more beloved cousins and his best friend Dan Walsh. He was pre-deceased by his parents and step-father.
