He attended school in Baltimore, MD, later graduated from Wyalusing High School, Wyalusing PA. William served his country in the United States Marine Corps, then serving in the USMC reserves as Sergeant. He was a forward air controller stationed at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba during the Cuban Missile Crisis. William was a lifetime volunteer firefighter for Towanda and North Towanda Fire Departments. William worked for Sylvania prior to his employment at DuPont where he retired from in 2000. He had served as boy scout leader, forest fire warden and various roles in the local fire departments.
