Wurt Walter "Bob" Brown, 80, of Rome Township, PA passed away August 9, 2024. Wurt was born in Towanda, PA on November 24, 1943, the son of Wurt Eugene Brown and Margaret Elizabeth Frederick Brown. He was a graduate of Northeast Bradford High School and later served with the U.S. Army in Vietnam during the war. Wurt was employed by the Ingersoll-Rand in Athens and E.I. DuPont in Towanda and later drove truck for Taylor Packing in Wyalusing for a number of years until his retirement. In early years, Wurt coached Little League Baseball and enjoyed attending the Little League World Series for many years. He was an avid follower of Northeast Bradford High School sports especially softball and basketball. Wurt was a former member of the Vigilante Engine Company in Rome. He loved nature, watching deer, and driving country roads.

Wurt was a life member of Beirne-Webster VFW Post No. 1568, Towanda, and Towanda American Legion Post No. 42.
